

Resolution to Support the *myFutureNC* Attainment Goal


- WHEREAS, The *myFutureNC* Commission is a statewide organization focused on educational attainment and is the result of cross-sector collaboration between North Carolina leaders in education, business, and government; and
- WHEREAS, The *myFutureNC* Commission has concluded that North Carolina should have a goal that 2 million North Carolinians will have a high-quality post-secondary degree or credential by 2030; and
- WHEREAS, The Cumberland County Workforce Development Board is committed to helping employers in our local area meet their workforce needs while helping job seekers find a rewarding career pathway; and
- WHEREAS, Employers in the local area have approximately 10,486 openings over the next ten years and many of these jobs require some type of education and/or training beyond a high school diploma; and
- WHEREAS, Most jobs in the local area that pay a family-sustaining wage require some type of education and/or training beyond a high school diploma.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT:

The Cumberland County Workforce Development Board strongly supports the attainment goal of *myFutureNC* Commission that 2 million North Carolinians will have a high-quality post-secondary degree or credential by 2030; and

The Cumberland County Workforce Development Board will continue to foster partnerships with local, regional, and state partners in order to increase the number of high-quality post-secondary credentials awarded in the local area to achieve the *myFutureNC* Commission goal.
