



Resolution to Support the myFutureNC Attainment Goal

WHEREAS, myFutureNC is a statewide non-profit organization focused on educational attainment and is the result of cross-sector collaboration between North Carolina leaders in education, business, and government; and

WHEREAS, The myFutureNC Commission has concluded that North Carolina should have a goal that 2 million North Carolinians will have a high-quality credential or postsecondary degree by 2030; and

WHEREAS, Northampton County Schools is committed to **safe, orderly, and effective schools that provide a whole learning environment and strong, competitive learners.**

WHEREAS, Northampton County Schools, along with other key partners, will help advance the educational attainment of students in North Carolina by **working in partnership with families and communities using a holistic approach to empower students to become responsible and engaged citizens.**

WHEREAS, Northampton County Schools agrees that North Carolina faces a gap between the projected needs for citizens with high-quality credentials or postsecondary degrees and the attainment of those high-quality credentials or postsecondary degrees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT:

Northampton County Schools supports the attainment goal of myFutureNC that 2 million North Carolinians should have a high-quality credential or postsecondary degree by 2030; and

Northampton County Schools, along with leaders in business, education, state and local government, and community organizations will continue to foster partnerships to achieve the goal.
