Resolution to Support the myFutureNC Attainment Goal

WHEREAS, myFutureNC is a statewide non-profit organization focused on educational attainment and is the result of cross-sector collaboration between North Carolina leaders in education, business and government; and

WHEREAS, The myFutureNC Commission has concluded that North Carolina should have a goal that 2 million North Carolinians will have a high-quality credential or postsecondary degree by 2030; and

WHEREAS, Nash County Public Schools is committed to providing all students with opportunities to develop career plans, as well as offering all students access to high-quality curricula and coursework to prepare the student for postsecondary opportunities based on their future career goals.

WHEREAS, Nash County Public Schools, along with other key partners, will help advance the educational attainment of students in North Carolina by providing students with opportunities to attain high-quality credentials in their chosen career path, providing students with real-world experiences, utilizing quality career pathway labs and equipment, aligning high school career pathways with higher education career pathways, and partnering with business, industry and organizations to provide students with postsecondary options upon graduation.

WHEREAS, Nash County Public Schools agrees that North Carolina faces a gap between the projected needs for citizens with high-quality credentials or postsecondary degrees and the attainment of those high-quality credentials or postsecondary degrees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT:

Nash County Public Schools supports the attainment goal of myFutureNC that 2 million North Carolinians should have a high-quality credential or postsecondary degree by 2030; and

Nash County Public Schools, along with leaders in business, education, state and local government, and community organizations, will continue to foster partnerships to achieve the goal.
