



Resolution to Support the myFutureNC Attainment Goal

WHEREAS, myFutureNC is a statewide non-profit organization focused on educational attainment and is the result of cross-sector collaboration between North Carolina leaders in education, business and government; and

WHEREAS, The myFutureNC Commission has concluded that North Carolina should have a goal that 2 million North Carolinians will have a high-quality credential or postsecondary degree by 2030; and

WHEREAS, Roanoke Rapids Graded School District is committed to attaining a goal of at least 50% of students graduating with a post-secondary credential or post-secondary degree, according to our myFutureNC County Gap to Goal for Halifax County, NC.

WHEREAS, Roanoke Rapids Graded School District, along with other key partners, will help advance the educational attainment of students in North Carolina by fostering meaningful relationships with all partners to ensure the academic, emotional, and social growth of all students.

WHEREAS, Roanoke Rapids Graded School District agrees that North Carolina faces a gap between the projected needs for citizens with high-quality credentials or postsecondary degrees and the attainment of those high-quality credentials or postsecondary degrees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT:

Roanoke Rapids Graded School District supports the attainment goal of myFutureNC that 2 million North Carolinians should have a high-quality credential or postsecondary degree by 2030; and

Roanoke Rapids Graded School District along with leaders in business, education, state and local government, and community organizations will continue to foster partnerships to achieve the goal.
