Resolution to Support the myFuture NC Attainment Goal

- WHEREAS,** myFutureNC is a statewide non-profit organization focused on educational attainment and is the result of cross-sector collaboration between North Carolina leaders in education, business, and government; and
- WHEREAS,** the myFuture NC Commission has concluded that North Carolina should have a goal that two million North Carolinians will have a high-quality credential or postsecondary degree by 2030; and
- WHEREAS,** Mid-Carolina Council of Governments is committed to supporting this goal; and
- WHEREAS,** Mid-Carolina Council of Governments, along with other key partners, will help advance the educational attainment of students in North Carolina by seeking out creative, collaborative solutions to challenges facing Cumberland, Harnett, and Sampson Counties; and
- WHEREAS,** Mid-Carolina Council of Governments agrees that North Carolina faces a gap between projected needs for citizens with high-quality credentials or postsecondary degrees and the attainment of those high-quality credentials or postsecondary degrees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT:

Mid-Carolina Council of Governments supports the attainment goal of myFutureNC that two million North Carolinians should have a high-quality credential or postsecondary degree by 2030; and

Mid-Carolina Council of Governments along with leaders in business, education, state and local government, and community organizations will continue to foster partnerships to achieve the goal.
