**WHEREAS**, North Carolina has the goal that 2 million North Carolinians will have a high-quality credential or postsecondary degree by 2030; and

**WHEREAS**, The Caldwell Chamber of Commerce is committed to ensuring that 51% of individuals ages 25 - 44 have a postsecondary degree or credential by 2030; and
